### TODAY'S GAME NOTES

#### ANCHORS AWAY

Good afternoon ladies and gentlemen and welcome to the RIC Soccer Field for today's Little East Conference men's soccer game between the Huskies of Southern Maine and your Rhode Island College Anchormen.

#### LAST TIME OUT

The Anchormen snapped a two-game losing streak by beating Westfield State, 4-2, on the road. Sophomore forward **BRUNO COSTA** netted a hat trick, while junior defender **COREY CARVALHO** scored the game-winning goal with his first collegiate marker in the 76th minute of play. RIC junior goalkeeper **HELDER FAUSTINO** made five saves in the win.

#### THE ANCHORMEN AT A GLANCE

Head Coach **JOHN MELLO'S** team comes into today's contest with a 6-7-2 overall record and a 3-2 record in the Little East. The Anchormen look to improve their conference record in hopes of making the conference tournament. Costa leads the team in both goals (9) and points (19). Junior midfielder **JOSE RUIZ** is second on the team in those categories with four goals and 11 points. Faustino is 3-3-1 with a 1.60 goals against average and a .744 save percentage since becoming the starting goalkeeper in late September.

#### THE HUSKIES AT A GLANCE

Head Coach **MIKE KELLER'S** team looks to end a two-game winless streak today. This past week the Huskies played in two overtime games and were unable to come out victorious. On Monday, USM hosted UMass Dartmouth to a 1-1 tie and on Wednesday the Huskies traveled to St. Joseph's and lost, 1-0. Junior midfielder **NICK JOHNSON** leads USM in goals (6) and points (16), while senior midfielder **PETER McHUGH** is close behind with 5-3-13 totals. Junior goalkeeper **DAVID KREPIS** has seen most of the action in net and has a 5-7-2 overall record, a 1.37 goals against average and a .756 save percentage.

#### LAST TIME WE MET

Last season, the Anchormen came back from Southern Maine with a disappointing- 1-0 loss. The win for the Huskies claimed the Little East Regular Season Championship and secured home field advantage for the conference tournament. **GREG COX** scored the lone goal for USM in the 75th minute, banging home a cross from **SINISA BAJIC** to break the scoreless tie.
